

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects

SPRING TIME TULIP PLATE



MATERIALS

DB37205 - Egg Plate

Fan Brush
Tulip Paper Pattern
Water Dish
Scissors
Yellow Sponge
Straight Pin

COLORS

CMM 55- Sea Mist
CMM 39 - Blue Green
CMM 3 - Carnation
CMM 69 - Carrot Juice
CMM 21 - Mango Madness
CMM 98 - Red Head



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Use scissors to cut out the tulips from your paper pattern.
- 2. We are going to use the paper painting technique and apply a heavy amount of Red Head and Coral Reef to the back of the tulip and set it on the plate.
- 3. Press down on the paper to make sure to work out any air, it's okay if paint leaks out.
- 4. Let the paint dry up a little while you cut out your leaves.
- 5. Take a liner brush and Blue Green Paint and make a stem for every flower.
- 6. Use the paper painting technique in steps 2-3 to add the leaves. Using Mango Madness, Sea Mist, and Blue Green.
- 7. Wipe off any major excess paint leaking out. No stress if you wipe a stem, we will be putting another layer again.
- 8. Use a fan brush to apply a layer or two of Mango Madness.
- 9. Take your liner brush and apply another coat of Blue Green to the stem.
- 10. Next we will make the dots using the back of a paint brush dipped in Carrot Juice.
- 11. Finally, use a straight pin to remove your paper pieces by poking the center and scooping it upward.

TIPS

- Make sure to apply a generous amount of paint to the back of the paper.
- Press the paper down, don't worry about the paint that leaks out!
- When you remove the paper, don't dig at the edge with the pin, it'll leave marks. Instead, poke in the middle and scoop upward.
