

# PAPA-SAURUS PLATE



## **MATERIALS**

DB37467 Squrve Dinner Plate
Handprint Dinosaur Silkscreen or
Pattern
Medium Brush
Liner Brush
Sponge Dabber
Alphabet Stamps

## **COL ORS**

CMM 64 – Sky Blue
CMM 31 – Licorice
CMM 27 – Kiwi
CMM 12 – Mocha Java




### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1.Use a pen to trace on your NCR pattern or use thickened Licorice to apply silkscreen.
- 2.Paint the child's hand with a heavy layer of Kiwi and press onto the center of the dinosaur's back. Repeat for as many as will fit.
- 3. Paint 3 coats of Kiwi to the rest of the dinosaur, leaving a little space around the hand prints.
- 4. Create the ground by painting 3 layers of Mocha Java to the plate.
- 5. Paint one messy layer of Sky Blue to the rest of the background, working around the handprints and dinosaur.
- 6.If you used a NCR pattern to trace on your dinosaur, use your liner brush to apply one layer of Licorice to the lines and face.
- 7. Finally, stamp on your letters using a sponge dabber to apply a thin layer of black to the letter before immediately pressing it down onto the plate.

#### TIPS

- When applying the pattern, make sure the color underneath is dry.
- Press down firmly to make sure it's transferring.
- Always peel the paper back to make sure you've transferred before removing.
- When outlining with a liner brush, hold the brush straight up and down to get thinnner lines, and press down for thicker lines.
- Use a thin layer of paint sponged onto the stamps for the best results.
