

SIMPLY STRAWBERRIES THUMBPRINT BOWL



MATERIALS

CCX3159 Kitchen Bowl Medium Brush Fan Brush Small Brush Detail Brush Detail Writing Bottle

COLORS

CMM 16 - Chiffon CMM 48 - Guacamole CMM 98 - Red Hot CMM 67 - Snowflake



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Start by applying a base coat of Snowflake using your fan brush on the outside of the bowl. This will create a bright white background, but will also help if you need to remove a thumbprint for any reason.
- 2. Next, paint the inside of the bowl, as well as the rim with 3 coats of Chiffon. We used the fan brush for the inside and the medium brush for the rim.
- 3. Use your medium brush to paint 3 coats of Chiffon to the handles of the bowl.
- 4. To apply the thumbprints, use a small brush to brush the Red Hot paint to the thumb, then immediately press it onto the bowl. Continue your way around the bowl until you've got the desired amount.
- 5. Use your detail brush to paint on the leaves for the strawberries, we did 2 generous coats.
- 6. Finally, use your detail writing bottle to apply white seeds on the strawberries.

TIPS

- Use gentle pressure when adding the seeds to the strawberries.
- If you're doing thumbprints for different children and intend on adding their names later, use a water based marker to write their names on the bowl next to their thumb. If will fire off so make sure to go back and put a name on permanently with paint.
- Be generous with the paint to get the most even color on the strawberries
