

# SANTA & ME HANDPRINT PLATE

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



## **MATERIALS**

CCX151 10" Coupe Dinner Plate

Large Brush

Detail Brush

Small Sponge on a Stick

Medium Sponge on a Stick

Waterbased Marker

## **COLORS**

CMM 27 - Kiwi
CMM 29 - Grasshopper
CMM 90 - Red Hot
CMM 31 - Licorice



## INSTRUCTIONS

If you're doing these plates for a painting with Santa event, we recommend having Santa put his hands on all the plates before the event. Then the day of you can have the kids do their hand and name, and you add the spots and writing!

- 1. Generously paint Grasshopper on Santa's left hand and print it down.
- 2. Next, generously paint Kiwi on the kiddo's right hand and print it down.
- 3. Use a water based marker and have the child write their name under the hand.
- 4. For the writing, use either a detail brush and Licorice paint or a writer bottle.
- 5. Finally, add your spots. Use Red Hot on your medium sponge dabber, and Kiwi on your small sponge dabber. We just did one coat on each.

### **TIPS**

- Tap off the excess paint from your dabber when you first dip it in.
- Apply paint to the hands generously for the best print.
